

In the project young people from different countries will create an enigma all together by using some elements and myths from their cultures and design their own Escape Room. They will have an empty house and materials to convert this house that is hidden in the mountains of Madrid, to an intercultural escape room.

What is an ESCAPE ROOM?

An escape room, also known as an "escape game", is a physical adventure game in which players solve a series of puzzles and riddles using clues, hints, and strategy to complete the objectives at hand. Players are given a set time limit to unveil the secret plot which is hidden within the rooms. Games are set in a variety of fictional locations, such as an office, a laboratory, prison cells, dungeons, and space stations, and usually the various puzzles and riddles themselves follow the theme of the room.

AIM OF THE PROJECT

As we all know, sometimes solving puzzles and play some games are hard but creating a good one is even harder. With this project we are aiming to create a challenge to push the participants to think divergently and creatively while discovering the other cultures and encourage them to work as a team with the other youngsters from other cultures to be able to compose a unic game. Participants will have to use lots of skills to succeed from creativity to design, decoration, construction and maybe even engineering.

MAIN ACTIVITIES

The activities will be based on the non-formal and informal educational working methods: workshops, courses, excursions, team activities, energizers, discussions, presentations and interviews of participants in the project. After learning theoretically the history, we will invite the participants to create a story based on a provided information. Once they have the theme created, they will start to design the puzzles. Later they will have an access to a house in a big garden to build the room and decorate it. When the room is created, the group will have chance to try their creation on the other volunteers of De Amicitia.

ACCOMMODATION AND THE LOCATION

Braojos is a municipality of Spain belonging to the Community of Madrid. It is included in the area of influence of the port of Somosierra, traditional step of the so-called "Camino de Francia", and in its term is also the port of Arcones. In 2017 it had a population of 200 inhabitants. 90 km away from Madrid and it takes approximately a bit more than 1 hour to reach it.

The accommodation will be done in a local hostel in the town which has 8 rooms with bunk several bunk beds in it and separate bathrooms and showers for boys and girls. There is also a huge and well equipped kitchen in the building.
